

# COVID-19 Guidelines

## Effective 12/29/2021

### **If you test positive for COVID-19:**

- Stay home and isolate for no less than 5 days
- If you have no symptoms or symptoms are getting better after 5 days, you can return to work.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until you are fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication.
- Continue to wear a mask per company policy (when on shift, no exceptions).
- CANNOT accept a home COVID-19 test, only rapid or PCR test.

### **If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19 and you have had your booster shot OR completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna in the last 6 months OR completed primary series of J&J in the last 2 months:**

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days (always wear a mask during shift, per company policy)
- Test on day 5, if possible (Rapid or PCR test)
- IF YOU DEVELOP SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME AND GET A TEST (RAPID OR PCR ONLY)
  - o If staff develops symptoms and has a positive test and had previous known exposure from other coworkers/consumers on shift, staff will be paid for their time in isolation.
- If you have had COVID-19 infection in the last 90 days, and are exposed, no quarantine is necessary, wear mask while on shift.
- If you are sick, stay home

### **If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19 and you completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna more than 6 months ago and did NOT get a booster, completed the primary series of J&J at least 2 months ago without booster OR are unvaccinated:**

- Quarantine for 5 days. After that, wear a mask for additional five days (continue to wear a mask per company policy).
- Test on day five if possible (rapid or PCR test only).
- IF YOU DEVELOP SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME AND GET A TEST (RAPID OR PCR ONLY)
  - o If staff develops symptoms and had previous known exposure from other coworkers/consumers on shift, staff will be paid for their time in isolation.
- If you have had COVID-19 infection in the last 90 days, and are exposed, no quarantine is necessary, wear mask indoors and while on shift.
  - o If you are sick, stay home
